As an Advanced Nurse/Clinical Practitioner PG Dip / MSc you will have had experience in Primary Care / Community Care and will have the ability to making professionally autonomous decisions, for which you are accountable for receiving patients with undifferentiated and undiagnosed problems and making an assessment of their health care needs, based on highly-developed nursing knowledge and skills, including skills such as physical examination, applied pharmacology and evidence-based prescribing.
